If you are applying to study an undergraduate course, you may be eligible to receive finance to help you cover the costs associated with this.

TYPES OF STUDENT FINANCE LOANS

There are two types of loans that you may be eligible to receive via Student Finance England: a tuition fee loan and a maintenance loan.

TUITION FEE LOAN → Fees charged by your university/college*

MAINTENANCE LOAN

Living costs (e.g. rent, bills and food)

*excluding private providers

MAINTENANCE LOAN AMOUNTS

The amount of maintenance loan you can receive depends on two factors:

1 Where you will be living during your studies

Your household income (i.e. it is 'means-tested')

The maximum maintenance loan amounts for 2020-2021 are:

Parent's/carer's home £7,747

Away from home (outside London) £9,203

Away from home (inside London) £12,010

Living and studying abroad £10,539

HOW AND WHEN DO I APPLY FOR STUDENT FINANCE?

Applications open in February/March and take about thirty minutes to complete. They can be made online at:

Apply as soon as possible in order to avoid delays in receiving your payments.

You do not need to have received and/or accepted university offers to apply.


