We are writing to provide a range of further updates about exam results this summer.

## **Autumn exam series**

Exam boards are providing an opportunity for students who want to improve their A Level or GCSE grade to sit exams in the Autumn Term. There is no charge for entering these exams. If you choose to sit these exams and achieve a different grade from the final grade you have achieved this summer you will be able to use the higher of the 2 grades.

## **Cam Tech results**

We will publish final grades for Cam Tech qualifications on the *My D*ata site on Thursday 27 August by 9am. The exam board OCR have not provided Centre Assessed Grades so we cannot populate that column of *My Data*. However, students can be reassured that the final grade is the highest of either the calculated or the Centre Assessed Grade, based on the centre assessed unit grades which we sent to OCR.

## **BTEC** results

We will release BTEC Level 3 final grades on the *My Data* site by 9am on Thursday 27 August. Again, students can be reassured that the final grade will be the highest of either the calculated or the Centre Assessed Grade. Pearson Edexcel have informed us that they will provide more information about the release of BTEC Level 2 results later in the week. If you are planning to progress from level 2 to level 3 at Worthing college please be reassured that we have all the information we need to make this decision.
