#### Confirming your year 13 courses



### is the magic number

- Students must confirm a full-time programme of THREE A Level courses or the equivalent in AS / BTEC / CamTech / Diploma / GCSE.
- There will be a small number of students who choose to continue with 4 courses

#### Progression criteria for Y13

#### You must:

- Pass first year courses you wish to continue. A Level students must pass June Internal Exams.
- 2. Attendance at least 90% from now until the end of the year.
- 3. Not be on stage 2-4 of the referral system.
- 4. Have a full time programme of study.

#### Is my decision final?

No. Final decisions will be made at start of Autumn term, following results. You can discuss changing your choices then.

## Can I request new courses for September 2021?

- Yes, as long as you meet the entry requirements for that course.

- We will check all requests for new courses and discuss them with you if we have concerns.



## Have you thought about the Extended Project in year 13?

- Worth half an A Level, graded A\*-E
- Carries UCAS points highly valued by universities
- A project on a topic of your choice
- Can be a written report; an investigation; a work of art or a performance
- Supported by a teacher 1 hr a week.



This would be on top of your 3 main courses

### How do I confirm my Year 13 choices?

- Discuss your choices with your parents / carers / teachers / tutor.
- On Monday 15 March you will be texted and emailed a link to a Microsoft Form.
- Complete the online form by Wednesday 24 March.
- We will arrange a meeting with any students where we have concerns.



## Will you be applying to university next year?

- Use the Microsoft Form to tell us if you are considering applying to university for Sept 2022.
- We will deliver UCAS workshops in June to help you prepare.
- Your tutor and the Progression Plus team will support you in the Autumn Term to complete your UCAS applications
